

**LOWER PAXTON TOWNSHIP  
AUTHORITY MEETING**

Minutes of Township Authority Meeting held May 7, 2013

A special meeting of the Lower Paxton Township Authority was called to order at 7:32 p.m. by Chairman William C. Seeds, Sr., on the above date in the Lower Paxton Township Municipal Center, 425 Prince Street, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania.

**New Business**

Resolution 13-09-01 through 13-09-05; authorizing the condemnation of temporary sewer easements for public sewers in the BC1A project

Mr. Wolfe noted that this resolution provides for the condemnation of temporary construction easement for properties located at 6044 Blackberry Lane, 6104 Linglestown Road,

6000 Linglestown Road, 6032 Linglestown Road, and 6078 Linglestown Road. He noted that the five listed properties require a temporary construction easement and staff has been unable to secure the easements for this work but will continue to attempt to secure the easements prior to filing for condemnation. He requested that the Board's take a favorable action at this time.
