2023 Lower Paxton Township Paving Project

Bid Opening held March 1, 2023

A bid opening was held on Wednesday, March 1, 2023, at 11:00 a.m. in Room 145 of the Lower Paxton Township Municipal Building, 425 Prince Street, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania. The bid proposal was for the 2023 Township Paving Project.

The following individuals were in attendance Jason Hinz, Tyler Hauber and Lindsay Bonanno via Zoom (teleconference), of Herbert, Rowland & Grubic, Timothy Nolt, Director of Public Works, Eric Kimmel, Road Technician, Randy Allen, Engineer Technician (MS4) and Shellie Smith, Recording Secretary.

Mrs. Bonanno noted that the Township received six bids for the project, with the lowest bid from New Enterprise Stone & Lime. Please see the chart below:
