To The Clerk of The Court Of Common Pleas, Dauphin County:

We, the undersigned Supervisors of Lower Paxton Township, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania, acting under and by virtue of the authority of the Second Class Township Code, Act of 1933, May 1, P.L. 103 No. 69, Re-enacted and amended November 9, 1995 (P.L. 350, No. 60) Section 2316, as amended, 53 Purdons Statues Section 67316, hereby request to the Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas of Dauphin County regarding certain streets, hereinafter named and described, that have been accepted by Resolution by said Board of Supervisors, said streets having been dedicated to use as public roads on plans approved and recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Dauphin County, Pennsylvania.

The Board of Supervisors of Lower Paxton Township at a regular meeting of said Board passed a Resolution, a true and exact copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference and marked exhibit "A", (including Resolutions 23-18, 23-20, 23-21) whereby the streets named and described in said Resolution were accepted by the Board of Supervisors of Lower Paxton Township as public roads, all of said streets having been previously dedicated to such use on approved and recorded plans filed in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Dauphin County, Pennsylvania.

The Board of Supervisors request the Clerk of Common Pleas of Dauphin County to be file and record this Report and Resolution and to deliver to the Board of Supervisors a certified and attested copy of such Resolution in conformity with the above cited.
