BUSINESS MEETING

Minutes for January 7, 2021

OLD BUSINESS

Kristy Kessler seconded the motion. Discussion proceeded with Bill Minsker suggesting that we change the design of our logo. He suggested that we get rid of the white background in our current log because it is too expensive. He said the most expensive shirt, being long sleeved, cotton and a polo shirt would cost \$30.00 and caps would be \$15.00. We would need a minimum of 12 orders being a mix of caps and shirts, or just one or the other. Sizes available are small, medium, large and extra-large. During discussion Don Goss mentioned that our current vendor has held shirts for almost a year without having completed them. After discussion, the adoption of

Stitchart was put forward and motioned by Bill Minsker and seconded by Don Goss. The motion was passed.
