**Reservations & Rentals**

*Rental locations: ball fields, courts, pavilions, Heroes Grove, and Municipal Center rooms. View each park's different amenities and rental fees online.*

*Pavilion Rentals - Each pavilion rental includes picnic tables and charcoal grills. Most pavilions have electricity and some parks have permanent restrooms. Rental time slots at our 12 pavilions are afternoon, evening or full day.*

*Payments and Refunds - Rental payments are accepted online and by phone or mail. Event, facility, and vendor permits will be issued upon approval and payment. Refunds are only issued if a reservation is canceled at least two weeks in advance. [bit.ly/3q7VGv](http://bit.ly/3q7VGv)*





# Park Improvements

The Lamplight playground was added in 2022, and this year a new trail that connects the park to George Park has been completed. Two new ADA accessible features include a rotating grill and a path to the pavilion. Our next step is to create a vegetated swale which collects and slows stormwater runoff. Lamplight is considered a neighborhood park.
