2024 OPENING DAY IN THE
PARKS WILL INCLUDE \$1M
BRIGHTBILL PARK RENOVATION



When our parks open in mid-March, residents will have a new, inclusive playground and picnic plaza to enjoy! The Brightbill Park design incorporates recreation areas for children ages 2-5 and 5-12.

A colorful "sound garden" with outdoor musical instruments will promote multi-sensory learning and play. The outdoor plaza will include new benches and picnic tables, including a wheelchair-accessible table.

Both existing outdoor grills will be replaced with two new units on a cement pad for easier access. A final park enhancement includes creating a paved path from the parking lot to an existing path in the nearby wooded area.
