## Happy Tails Dog Park

Happy Tails Dog Park is located within Kohl Memorial Park. The dog park is built on almost two acres and features an area for larger dogs, and a separate area for smaller dogs. The park is surrounded by 5-foot fencing with double-gate entrances for the safety of the dogs. It is a great spot for dog owners to meet and allow their pets to play and socialize. Bring your own water for dogs.

### Rules

- It is important that the rules in place are followed to avoid confrontations or issues between pets.
- Users of the dog park do so at their own risk.
- Lower Paxton Township and the Dog Park Association shall not be liable for injuries to dogs, owners/handlers, or others who use the dog park.
- This area is for dogs and owners/handlers only.
- The owner is wholly responsible for any injuries inflicted by their dog.
- Prevent injuries by supervising your dog at all times.
- Dog owners are legally and financially responsible for their dog's behavior.
- Aggressive dogs are not allowed.
- If you are asked to leave due to the behavior of your dog, you must comply.
- Dog owners must be within the fenced area and within view and voice control of their dogs at all times.
- Owners must clean up after their dogs.
- All dogs must be spayed or neutered.
- All dogs must be properly licensed, healthy, have current vaccinations, and shall have visible tags.
- No dogs over 30 pounds permitted in the small dog area.
- Leash laws apply outside the fenced area.
- No dogs under the age of four months (16 weeks) are permitted.
- No animals other than dogs are permitted.
- No children under 5 years of age are permitted inside the fence.
- No more than 3 dogs or children per handler.
- No food, human or canine, is permitted in the park.
- Owners/handlers must stop their dogs from digging and immediately fill any holes dug.
- Excessive barking is prohibited.
- Dogs parking excessively must be removed.
- Violations of the rules will result in payment of fines and fees. Violators may also be denied use of park facilities.
