Minutes of Board Meeting held March 24, 2015

The special business meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Lower Paxton Township was called to order at 6:33 p.m. by Chairman William B. Hawk, on the above date, in the Lower Paxton Township Municipal Center, 425 Prince Street, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania.

Supervisors present in addition to Mr. Hawk were: William C. Seeds, Sr., William L. Hornung, Gary A. Crissman and Robin L. Lindsey.

Also in attendance was George Wolfe, Township Manager; Steve Stine, Township; and Watson Fisher, SWAN.

**Pledge of Allegiance**

Mr. Crissman led in the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Approval of Minutes**

There were no minutes to be approved.

**OLD BUSINESS**

Action on bids for the sale of municipal vehicles

Mr. Wolfe noted, about two months ago, Lower Paxton Township advertised for bids for what was a large volume of vehicles and equipment. He noted that the Board accepted two bids at that time, rejected others, and received no bids on several items. He noted that the Board re-advertise in accordance with the Pennsylvania Second Class Township Code under the Municibid Program which is an online auction service for governmental entities. He noted that

there were multiple bidders for each items that were offered for auction by the Township and noted that the high bid amount was listed for each item on the bid tabulation sheet.

Mr. Wolfe noted the following items and the high bid amount:

Mr. Wolfe noted these bid amounts total \$54,485.00. He noted that that last time we bid locally and advertised locally we received total bids in the amount of \$1,800. He noted that it is staff's recommendation that you act to accept the high bid amounts as he has summarized it.

Ms. Lindsey suggested that the Township should stay with this type of bid process.

Mr. Crissman made a motion to accept the bid amounts with the sale of Municibid for the vehicles and equipment as outlined by Mr. Wolfe in the total amount of \$54,485. Ms. Lindsey seconded the motion. Mr. Hawk called for a voice vote and a unanimous vote followed.
