ORDINANCE NO. 18-03**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 23, MANAGER, OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF
LOWER PAXTON TOWNSHIP BY DELETING THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT.**

WHEREAS, Chapter 23 of the Codified Ordinances of Lower Paxton Township details the duties, responsibilities, and job requirements of the Township Manager; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to amend Chapter 23 of the Codified Ordinances to delete the Lower Paxton Township residency requirement for the Manager.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of Lower Paxton Township that Chapter 23, Section 23-3, Qualifications, is hereby amended as follows (*strike-through text deleted*):

§ 23.3. The Manager shall be chosen solely on the basis of his executive and administrative abilities, with special reference to his actual experience in or his knowledge of accepted practices in respect to the duties of his office as here in outline. ~~The Manager need not be a resident of the Township of Lower Paxton or of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania at the time of his appointment, but as soon as possible thereafter he shall become and during his tenure shall remain a resident of Lower Paxton Township.~~

REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its enactment.
