

## PUBLIC NOTICE

The Board of Supervisors of Lower Paxton Township hereby gives public notice that it will hold a public hearing to consider Ordinance 19-04 during the regular business meeting to be held on June 4, 2019 at 7:00 pm in the Township Municipal Building, 425 Prince Street, Harrisburg, PA.

Ordinance 19-04 would amend Section Two of Ordinance 95-07, which sets forth an allocation procedure for building permits in the Beaver Creek sanitary sewer basin.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Lower Paxton Township, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania as follows:

Section Two of Ordinance 95-07, which sets forth an allocation procedure for building permits in the Beaver Creek sanitary sewer basin, is hereby amended as follows:

8. Building permits authorized by the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the Swatara Township Authority (STA) in the Settlement Agreement, which settles the litigation regarding the prohibition of the connections to the Beaver Creek Interceptor, shall be issued pursuant to this Ordinance for the period of April 1, 2019 – March 31, 2020 as follows:
  - a. In accordance with the Settlement Agreement, the 331 surplus permits shall be allocated to achieve a permit ratio of 60% for the Developer-Petitioners and 40% to Developers and individuals. The Developer-Petitioners shall be allocated 199 permits and Developers and other individuals 132 permits.
  - b. In accordance with the Settlement Agreement the 168 permits received by letter dated March 21, 2019 from STA shall be allocated as follows; Developer-Petitioners shall be issued 96 permits, Developers and other individuals 72 permits.

Section Three: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section Four: If any section or any part of any section of this Ordinance is held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid for any reason, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected by the unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity and shall remain in full force and effect.

Following the public hearing the Board of Supervisors will consider enactment of Ordinance 19-04.

Ordinance No. 19-04 shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its enactment.

A copy of Ordinance 19-04 may be examined without charge or a copy of the Ordinance may be obtained for the cost to prepare the copy at the Lower Paxton Township Municipal Center during regular business hours.
